<u>The Euthanasia Deception, We are all Vulnerable</u> is a documentary that may be ordered by going to the website <u>caringnotkilling.com</u>. Councils may purchase it for \$30 or rent and download it. The DVD comes with helpful resource material, including a discussion guide. The Euthanasia Prevention Coalition is asking councils to share the documentary with others by organizing screenings in their community. The DVD is the first part in a social media resistance campaign. Councils may join the resistance campaign by becoming a member of the Euthanasia Prevention Coalition.

Ministry to seniors is an important part of our Christian life. Offer a senior a ride to church, or go to the grocery store for, or with, them. Many seniors are lonely. Give the gift of time to shut in seniors. With winter approaching it will be more difficult for seniors to get around as many of them do not drive in the winter. Many areas offer a free exercise program for seniors. It teaches them balance and strengthens muscles. How about joining and offering a senior a ride - win win. You get a free fitness class and a senior gets exercise and a social outing.

Instead of your usual monthly meeting you could host an information evening. Book a speaker and invite all the ladies of the parish to come. Serve light refreshments if you like. Some suggested topics are phone scams and fraud, wills and power of attorney. Have a pampered chef party, any orders will be an instant fundraiser.
