## Provincial

At the recent provincial council of The Catholic Women's League of Canada, members in attendance approved the following resolutions:

- a) ON.18.01 Develop national standards for levels of pharmaceuticals in Canada's drinking water.
- b) ON.18.02 Immediate Implementation of Income Security: A Roadmap for Change for Ontarians with a Disability. The resolution resolves that: the Ontario provincial council of the CWL in 71<sup>st</sup> annual convention assembled urge the Ontario provincial government to immediately implement the recommendations of Income Security: A Roadmap for Change pertinent to Ontarians with a disability.

c) ON.18.03 To fully implement alternative sentencing to incarceration of indigenous offenders.

## National

At the 2018 annual national convention held in Winnipeg, three resolutions were adopted:

- a) **2018.01 Attestation Requirement on Canada Summer Jobs Program** urges the federal government to remove the attestations for all future Canada Summer Jobs Programs.
- b) 2018.02 Setting a Standard for Products Marketed as Flushable urges the federal government to establish a national standard of testing and labelling of products marked as "flushable" and that provincial councils become aware of this issue as it pertains to their province/territory and to work on it as deemed necessary/prudent.
- c) **2018.03 Legislate Designation of Hospice/Palliative Care, Free from Medical Assistance in Dying-** urges the federal government to legislate the designation of hospice/palliative care services in facilities to exclude medical assistance in dying and that provincial councils become aware of this issue as it pertains to their province/territory and to work on it as deemed necessary/prudent.
