### **Social and Economic Justice**

## **Refugees, Immigration and Citizenship**

Write to the Prime Minister, the minister of immigration and your member of parliament, urging them to amend the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* so that foreign workers may apply for permanent resident status regardless of occupational classification.
