Become Informed about Bill - 45 (The Cannabis Act)

History was made on Oct 27th, 2018 with the passing of Bill - 45, as Canada became the second country in the world to fully legalize marijuana for recreational use. Canadians may now purchase a variety of cannabis products from licensed producers/retailers at retail locations authorized by the provinces/territories.
