The current resolution 2023.01 *To Establish a Sustained Intermittent Catheter Coverage* was presented and adopted at the 76<sup>th</sup> Ontario Provincial Convention in July. The resolution has been posted on [www.cwl.on.ca](http://www.cwl.on.ca). The action plan for this resolution directs us to "write letters to the Ontario Minister of Health and local MPPs", and to "educate members on the challenges individuals experience in acquiring intermittent urinary catheters for bladder emptying".

At the 103<sup>rd</sup> National Meeting of Members, the national council adopted Resolution 2023.01 *Combating Textile Waste in Canada*. This resolution has been posted on [www.cwl.ca](http://www.cwl.ca). This resolution calls us to raise awareness by inviting speakers or holding workshops and encouraging members to participate in the annual federal Waste Reduction Week in Canada.
