ADVENT STATIONS


Advent is upon us — we are called to 'Wait in Joyful Hope' and prepare ourselves for the coming of our Saviour. Some of you may recall a virtual Advent prayer service we held back in 2021. It was called Advent Stations. What are the Advent Stations you ask? The Advent Stations take us on a tour of the Old Testament. Like the traditional Lenten Stations of the Cross, these seven Advent "stations" or "stopping points" provide a way to ponder the mystery of how God prepared the world to receive His Son at the moment of the Annunciation. Each station contains an Old Testament foreshadowing of the incarnation, a meditation, the New Testament fulfillment in Christ, and then a prayer. They are a wonderful way to spend some time with your CWL sisters and pray.
